

Nomination for ISAE Awards 1984-85

ISAE invites nominations for the following Awards instituted to recognise the outstanding contributions of its members in any field of Agricultural Engineering as also in the fulfilment of ISAE's objectives.

1. **GOLD MEDAL**—Awarded to any member with at least 20 years professional experience and 15 years of ISAE membership in good standing.
2. **COMMENDATION MEDAL** Awarded to any member with 15 years professional experience and 10 years of ISAE membership in good standing.
These Awards are instituted in the areas of Teaching, Research and Development, Extension, Industry, Service to the profession, and service to farmers.
3. **DISTINGUISHED SERVICES AWARD**—Merit certificates in the similar fields as mentioned in 2 above are awarded to members with professional experience and ISAE membership of at least 5 years.
4. **SPECIAL AWARD**—To individual member enrolling more than 50 members during the period April to June, 1984. Similar award for 83-84 will also be given for enrolling more than 50 new members during the period April-June 1983.
5. **JYOTI MEDAL**—Cash award of Rs. 500 will be awarded

- for best paper on seeding, planting and harvesting equipment presented in the XXII Convention to the Author (s) who should be current member of ISAE of any category. The paper should be based on original or developmental research carried out by Author (s) in India.
6. **BEST CHAPTER AWARD**—Will be award to best ISAE Chapter based on the overall performance of the Chapter in terms of professional activities and enrolling new members.
7. **REDDY AWARD**—Will be awarded for best post-graduate thesis in Agricultural Engineering submitted in 1984.
8. **STUDENT PAPER AWARD**—Cash award of Rs. 200 and Rs. 250 awarded to any student member of ISAE whose paper is judged as best paper by a panel of jury. The papers would be presented in the XXII Convention. The papers should preferably be by an individual student and should not be co-authored by any ISAE member. These are six awards for student paper, 3 for under-graduate and 3 for post-graduate students.

THE LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF NOMINATIONS IS 30th June 1985

The nominations in triplicate may be sent to the Secretary, ISAE

under registered post. On the prescribed proforma.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD

- (i) Awards will be made only if, in the opinion of the Awards Committee, recognition is due.
- (ii) In deserving cases, when the Committee so decides, under the same head more than one Award can be given.
- (iii) Awards will not be the same awardee for the same subject before the expiry of 3 years.
- (iv) The decision of the Committee is final and no appeal will be entertained.
- (v) The Executive Committee of ISAE may, from time to time, revise or modify the criteria for Awards.
(a) The nomination for awards at Sl. No. 1, 2, 3 shall be sent with complete biodate in the prescribed nomination form along with complete details of the work done by him through proper channel (to be forwarded by the Head of the Institution/ Organization/ Department). For professional activities the nominations need not be forwarded through the Head of the organization.

(b) Nomination for award at Sl. No. 4 may be sent directly with full details of the member of new members enrolled and may be deposited at the ISAE Headquarters.

(c) For award at Sl. No. 5, Abstract of the paper may be sent. Full text of the paper may be brought for the presentation to the XXII Annual Convention.

(d) Nomination for award at Sl. No. 6 may be sent by the Chairmen of the ISAE Chapters with full report and audited account for 1983-84.

(e) For award at Sl. No. 7, thesis may be sent under registred post, the same will be returned.

(g) For award at Sl. No. 8, abstract of the paper may be sent. Full text of the paper shall be brought for presentation in the XXII Annual Convention.

Institution/University to which the student belongs should be an affiliate member of the ISAE.

1.2 The awards will be given to two categories of students namely, under-graduate and post-graduate.

1.3 There will be three prizes each of the value of Rs. 200 for the best three under-graduate student papers and three prizes each of the value of Rs. 250 for best three post-graduate student papers.

1.4 The papers will be selected for the prizes by a panel of jury to be nominated by the Director Awards in different areas. The selection of papers shall be made depending upon the technical content, quality and presentation of papers. The Jury may decide not to give any award if none of the papers is upto the mark.

1.5 The award shall be subject to minimum number of 5 participants. The Director Awards may, however, relax this condition depending upon the quality of the papers received.

1.6 The student member will be required to present the papers personally in the XXII ISAE Convention. The travel expenditure of the student will not be borne by the ISAE. In

deserving cases, where such support is not available, ISAE may consider supporting the expenses to the extent of second class return railway fare by the shortest route. The student should avail concessional tickets whenever available and the balance amount will be met by the ISAE. This would, however, not be applicable to foreign student. Prior approval of the President, ISAE may be taken for reimbursement of the travel expenses.

1.7 The paper meant for competition should be sent to the Director, ISAE Awards, by 30th June 1985. The Director Awards can, however extend the last date of receipt for the students papers, if necessary.

1.8 The students may choose a topic from any of the following broad areas :

(a) Farm Power and Machinery.

(b) Soil and Water Engineering.

(c) Agricultural Processing and Structure.

(d) Dairy and Food Engineering.

(e) Agro Industries.

(f) Energy in Agriculture

1.9 The length of under-graduate student paper shall not exceed 2000 words and that of post graduate students 3000 words.

CRITERIA FOR STUDENTS PAPER AWARD 1984-85
