Proceedings of the Annual General-body Meeting (AGM) - 2022 held on 09.11.2022 at 6:00PM at Anna Auditorium of TNAU, Coimbatore

The ISAE's Annual General-body Meeting (AGM) – 2022 was held on November 9, 2022 at 6.00PM at Anna Auditorium of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore during the 56th Annual Convention of ISAE under the chairmanship of Dr. S. N. Jha, President ISAE. A large number of delegates (the ground floor of hall was full with members and participants) attended the meeting. The office bearers other than the president who shared the dais were Prof. Indra Mani, Immediate Past President, Dr. D.M. Kadam, Vice President (Activity Council), Dr. Ambrish Kumar, Vice President (Technical Council), Dr. P.K. Sahoo, Secretary General, Dr. A.K. Thakur, Treasurer and all directors of both Technical and activity councils, and members of executive councils as appended. The other prominent members who graced the occasion were Prof. Gajendra Singh, Dr. V.M. Mayande, Prof. B.C. Mal, Dr. Nawab Ali, Dr. Gyanendra Singh and many others. At the outset, the Secretary General welcomed all the executive members on dais and members of ISAE off the dais. With permission of the Chair proceedings of the AGM was started with the confirmation of agenda items circulated through different media and put on the ISAE website. All members present in the meeting approved the agenda and the meeting started with brief welcome address by the President, ISAE.

1. Confirmation of the minutes of last GB meeting held at Patna on Nov 23, 2021

The Secretary General read the proceedings of the AGM held in Patna on 23/11/2021 and informed the house about the actions taken during the period between two AGMs on the recommendations of the last AGM. The house confirmed and approved the proceedings/minutes of the meeting of AGM held in 2021 at Patna.

2. Vice-Presidents (Technical & Activity Councils) and Annual Reports

As the AGM was started late and many items were listed to be discussed, the reports of both Vice-presidents and that of the Secretary General were presented as combined report by the Secretary General and the same is at Annexure I as ISAE Annual Report – 2022. The report was approved with lot of appreciations to the present executive of the ISAE.

3. Report by Treasurer

Dr. Abhay Kumar Thakur, the treasurer of the society presented the audited account of the society. The society was having fixed deposits to the tune of Rs. 16873694/- as on 09.11.2022. He also informed about the property tax paid to New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) and regularization of the same etc. The annual expenditure of the society is much more than the annual income, if interest on FD and rent of ISAE property are not computed. He also informed the house about pending dues of Punjab and Bihar Chapters to ISAE headquarter after conference/convention organized by the respective chapters. Dr. Thakur informed the house about efforts being put by the present executive for generation of funds through several means, including advertisements in AET and e-newsletter, financial grants from ICAR, MoJS, NABARD and CSIR for conducting the 56th Annual Convention. The members applauded the efforts being put for income generation. The AGM approved the audited report and adopted the same with voice vote.

4. Ratification of Modified ISAE logo, tagline, change in name of JAE to JAE (India), New/revised format of AET and making it open access, ISAE wall calendar 2023, rent agreement of ISAE flats' renewal, Editorial boards of JAE(I) and AET, removal of Jain irrigation award

The Secretary General presented the modified new logo, tagline, and change in name of JAE to JAE (India) to the house. Also the proposal of new/revised format of AET and making it open

access, printed wall callender-2023, rent agreement of ISAE flats, Editorial board of JAE(I), AET, and keeping some nominated persons as publication heads in the ISAE Headquarter were presented by the Secretary General. The president explained about the entire process of doing the above-mentioned activities to make the society more professional and vibrant. The proposal for removal of the Jain Irrigation Award from the award list of the society was also discussed and agreed upon by the AGM. The ISAE fraternity were extremely happy with so many positive and vibrant changes in the society in a short span of the new executives. The AGM ratified all above as presented and the changes were incorporated on the website of the society.

5. Information/discussion on work carried out and vacancies of Agricultural Engineers/ opening of Directorate in each state and B. Tech. in each IIT/NIT

The president informed the house about various activities taken up by the society on the above-mentioned issues during the period. Some of those were, writing letters to different state Govts. for Agri Engineering Vacancies, letters by the honourable Minister Shree Rupalajee for opening of Directorate of Agricultural Engineering in each state and letter to Hon'ble HRD minister for more Agri-Engineering Departments in IIT/NITs by the President, ISAE. Starting of B.Tech. Programme in more places, creation of more vacancies in different states/private organizations, expansion of directorates and responses received from different state Governments were highly appreciated by the ISAE members.

6. Discussion and adoption of Draft Revised and updated Constitution, Bye-laws and rules

The Secretary General presented the final draft of the revised and updated ISAE constitution; bye-laws and rules approved by the executive committee and councils, which was shared on the ISAE website and sent to members by mail much before the AGM. The Secretary General explained about entire procedure and great efforts by the Committee to finalize the draft. Few suggestions were received from the members and were incorporated. Prof. Gajendra Singh thereafter requested Dr. Mayande, Chairman of the ISAE constitution revision committee to explain about the major changes in the document from podium. Dr. Mayande meticulously explained major changes in the final draft and explained about the rationale behind them. There were disagreements of few members on the donation of Rs. 5000/- to society by the person awarded with ISAE fellowship. After intense discussion, the house adopted the revised and updated ISAE Constitution, bye-laws and rules. The president then announced that a referendum may be conducted on issues of "Rs. 5000/- donation by the new fellows to be selected" using ISAE website for which a new facility has been made. The referendum button will remain open from tomorrow and Hon'ble members may cast their votes in favour or against the issue for the next 15 days. If the result will come in the favour of this issue, it will be retained other-wise deleted from the documents. All Hon'ble members including those who were opposing agreed for the same. The referendum was conducted. Total vote casted were 49 out of which 40 was in the favour of donating Rs. 5000/- to the society by the newly selected fellows from the next years. The result of the referendum was also put up in the 13th ISAE Executive committee meeting held on the 4th November 2022 and the same was approved. The ISAE New Revised and updated ISAE Constitution, bye-laws and rules therefore were adopted with effect from the 9th November 2022 at Coimbatore.

7. Authorization of Executive Committee to appoint Auditor for 2022-24

The treasurer put up the issue to AGM to approve the appointment of a new Auditor or continue with the earlier one. The house authorised the executive committee to do the needful.

8. Review of organization of ISAE Convention

The Honorable members present in the house appreciated and congratulated the organizing team for nice arrangements and grand success of inaugural function, Industry session, the International Symposium of the 56th ISAE convention and International Symposium.

9. Venue of next ISAE convention in 2023

The Secretary General informed the house about the proposals from UAS Raichur and VNMKV, Parbhani to organize the next annual convention of ISAE in 2023. The AGM with the recommendation of Executive Committee approved UAS, Raichur as the venue for the 57th ISAE Annual convention.

11. Presidential Address

The President, ISAE delivered a passionate and short address in the AGM (09.11.2022) due to paucity of time, and exhorted all ISAE members to be active and contribute to Society and Science for welfare of common man. He informed the house to be ready for hard decision to be taken by the present executive for making the ISAE not only more vibrant, but also professional and up to mark of the best society in the world. He said each and every member are being given equal opportunity and facilities for enhancing their capacities and fulfilling the aspirations, whether they are working in industries, governments, NGOs, or in academia/research institutes. Each member need to update his/her profile on the website. He assured the house that the ISAE shall be a true professional society and the best amongst the scientific society in the country within short span of two/three years. He requested each member to help the EC for achieving the goal and thanked every member for participation in AGM in record number and active & intense discussion on each issue.

The vote of thanks to the chair and all honourable members of AGM was proposed by the Secretary General and meeting ended at about 9.30PM.

Meetings: During the period Jan. 2022 to till date, 3 executive councils, 12 (one in every month) executive committee, 14 special, and 10 meetings at ISAE HQ were held. Several Editorial boards' meetings of JAE and AET were also held. The committee members discussed on several important issues and took decisions relating to the efficient functioning of the society. He also briefed about the membership status till date.

Publications

The Journal of Agricultural Engineering (JAE) published as per schedule, sent to the members through e-mail, and placed on ISAE website. However, Agricultural Engineering Today (AET) was delayed due to transitional phase caused by change in Editorial Board. However, now AET publication is updated and latest issue is in press. Hard copies of JAE and AET are being sent to the corporate members and subscribers. The Society is also publishing e-newsletter containing activities of Society on bi-monthly basis. We are thankful to Dr. Dipankar De, Editor-in-Chief (JAE), and Er. Mamta Jain Editor-in-Chief (Agricultural Engineering Today), and their team for excellent job. We also extend our sincere appreciation to Er. Chandra Shekhar, Chief Editor (e-newsletter) for publication of bi monthly ISAE newsletter.

Launch of ISAE calendar-2022

On the auspicious day of 75th Republic Day dated 26th Jan., 2022, The President of ISAE released the ISAE calendar 2022. Due to the Covid pandemic situation, the launch ceremony was organized through zoom meeting in which ISAE members across India Joined and made it a great success. The ISAE calendar 2022 depicts the glorious history of ISAE, JAE, AET, Past Presidents, Awardees, Chapters and various other details in different pages. The calendar was distributed to Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, GoI, and other Govt. /Pvt. Offices for wide publicity of ISAE society

Efforts for Separate Agri-Engineering Directorates to boost Mechanization

As India loses over Rs.1 lakh crores annually due to post harvest losses, the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has suggested creation of separate Directorate of Agricultural Engineering at least at block level in every State as it could help substantially reduce the losses and boost farmers' income. The Agricultural Engineers are not available even at district levels in most of the states. Even if they are available, their services have been utilized in other areas like seeds distribution in those states where there is no separate directorate. The creation of separate directorate was proposed by Dr. S.N. Jha, Deputy Director General (Engineering) at ICAR. He has suggested the agriculture ministry to impress upon States to create separate directorate of Agricultural Engineering.

Launching of ISAE New Website

The previous website was not functioning satisfactorily. Hence, the EC decided to re-develop the ISAE website through expert agency and after identifying the suitable website developer, the website was developed in record time of 3 months and the new website of ISAE was launched on 25.06.2022 Dr. Trilochan Mohapatra, Secretary (DARE) & DG, ICAR, New Delhi. The launching ceremony was conducted online. The Secretary (DARE) & DG, ICAR, New Delhi was the Chief Guest and the President, ISAE & DDG(Engg) was Guest of Honor. The Secretary General coordinated the programme.

The new ISAE website consists of job portal, payment gateway, referendum button, online membership applications etc. The Corporate/ institutional members can post their job openings, free of cost and bona-fide members can directly apply through website against particular openings. Non-members can also post their job openings on payment basis.

Online lecture series in collaboration with ISAE & RMSI

There are many more crops other than cereals, pulses and oilseeds, which might have innovative

utilization and have scope for improving livelihood of farmers. In this direction, ABI Centre of Indian Grassland and Fodder Research Institute, Jhansi (ICAR-IGFRI, Jhansi) initiated a lecture series on the occasion of celebrating Diamond Jubilee year (1962-2022) of ICAR-IGFRI Jhansi and 75 years of independence of India (AzadikaAmritMahotsav) from 23rd April 2022 on the third Saturday of every month. The IGFRI Diamond Jubilee Online Lecture Series-2022 on "Entrepreneurship Development in Processing Fodder and Allied Crops" was being conducted online on Zoom platform in association with Indian Society of Agriculture Engineers, New Delhi and the Range Management Society of India, Jhansi. Till Oct. 2022, 11 lectures had been conducted.

ISAE AET new editorial board and new version

The ISAE AET new Editorial Board was constituted and several meetings of editorial board of AET were conducted. The first release of AET by the new editorial board was made in new look/version and format for April-June 2022. It contains mostly articles from industries, technical articles from the scientists, upcoming technologies, important news clippings related to aims and objectives of the society. The journal is looking like a fully commercial magazine. It has got numerous applauds even from overseas. The number of users for the journal is rapidly growing.

Annual Convention

The 55th ISAE Annual Convention and International Symposium was successfully organised jointly by the College of Agricultural Engineering, RPCAU, Pusa (Bihar), ISAE, New Delhi and BAMETI, Patna (Bihar) during November 23-25, 2021 at Patna. In the convention, more than 350 delegates from different states of the country and abroad participated physically. About 300 academicians / scientists/ students/ engineers were connected virtually. Total 19 technical sessions, on various themes, were conducted in four parallel sessions and total 286 research papers presented in offline & online mode. Local manufacturers' meet was also held as the side business to share their views with the ISAE executives and state Govt. officials. General body meeting of ISAE was also held at Gyan Bhavan

ISAE Chapters

There are altogether 36 Chapters functioning in the Society. It is very enthusiastic to have more number of chapters showing strength of the society. The important reports and activities of the chapters are also published in ISAE E-newsletter. It is a great pleasure that the ISAE chapters are organizing webinars and other activities very frequently and in a big way.

Other New Initiatives

- Oath taking ceremony was organized for the first time in ISAE, and all elected members took oath, solemnized by the outgoing president of ISAE
- Director (Gender Issue) has been created to address the gender issues in Agri. Engineering
- Constitution amendment committee has been formed for revisiting the existing ISAE constitution and proposing the amendments
- Score Cards for different ISAE Awards
- ISAE Student membership (free for Diploma/UG/Degree in Agril. Engg. Drive
- Life membership and corporate membership Drive
- Redesigning of ISAE logo

Important Decisions/Initiatives

- Discussion on various suggestions received for Award score card was made and several decisions were taken unanimously by the Hon'ble members and score card was approved by the EC
- It was suggested that region wise ISAE state chapters meeting to be organized to revitalize the chapters. Every month's second or third Saturday may be fixed for the purpose
- The tag line for ISAE website was finalized as ISAE connecting Engineers in Agriculture
- To allow more researchers to submit articles in JAE and AET, the life membership of ISAE for the authors is not compulsory. Anyone can submit relevant research articles to JAE for publication. This provision is being made in the new website for everyone to register and

submit articles

- The president made the members aware about the Scientific Society's Social responsibility (SSSR) and all the members to come up with some plan to fulfill the obligation of society through SSSR.
- A proposal from Dr. P K Pathak, Director (PDFE) for conducting entrepreneurship programme at Srinagar under banner of ISAE and AICRP was approved.
- Dr. Ambrish Kumar, Vice-President (Technical Council) was given responsibility to draft the booklet on "History of ISAE" or "Glorious Six Decades of ISAE" using materials/frameworks/guidelines given by the Prof. Gajendra Singh and the President, ISAE.
- Corporate Membership charges was raised to Rs. 100000/- (Rupees One Lakhs) w.e.f 16th Aug. 2022 with the approval of Executive Committee.
- It was decided by the EC to distribute the certificate of appreciation to previous executive members of ISAE and awardee of Conceptathon during ISAE convention at Coimbatore.
- The draft of ISAE constitution was prepared after number of deliberations among the committee members as well as executive members. The draft of ISAE constitution will be tabled before the General body meeting during the convention to be held at Coimbatore for final adoption.
